Mission

Honor and recognize Ridley Park's servicemen and women who are currently or have honorably served or given their lives to our country.

Application Requirements

In order to be considered for a banner, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

1. Lived in the Ridley Park at some point in their lifetime
2. Served in one of the following branches: Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, National Guard, Coast Guard.
3. Meet one of the following criteria: currently serving, honorably discharged Veteran, or died in the line of duty.

Banner Design, Time Frame & Location

Memorial Day through Veterans Day

Banners are 48"x 18", double sided, vinyl material and include service person's name, rank, branch of service, era of service and photograph.

Banners will be displayed on telephone poles along Veterans Park and throughout the business district.

Banner locations will be selected randomly, and specific display locations cannot be requested.

Banner Photograph

Please secure the photograph you would like to use on the banner. Photos can be scanned at 150 dpi at full size and saved in Jpeg or flash drive.

Banner Pricing & Donations

A \$250.00 donation is requested for each banner application submitted. Donation includes the production of the banner, installation, and removal. Funds may also be used towards repairing the Ridley Park Clock.

Banners will be displayed for year then removed and given to the family as a keepsake. Any banners not collected from Borough Hall within a 6-month period become property of Ridley Park Borough.

There are a limited number of locations available for the 2022 program. For an additional \$50.00 fee, your family members banner can be hung for an additional year.
